Description

The Voting Rights Working Group seeks volunteers to assist with loading federal voting rights cases into the University of Michigan Civil Rights Litigation Clearinghouse database. We have identified cases that are coded in the FJC Integrated Database as voting rights cases and we need volunteers to review the cases, code them appropriately, and draft brief summaries. The cases will then be made available to the public for free for use as a comprehensive voting rights case database.

Volunteers will be expected to commit to coding at least 5 cases (~10-15 hours) and will be provided with two training documents and two training videos.
