### Description


The Racial Equity and Justice Committee (REJC) of the Massachusetts Access to Justice Commission seeks the assistance of a summer associate to research information about the collection and usage of data on racial and ethnic disparities in civil cases (and especially, but not only, in housing, family law, and consumer debt cases) in state courts around the country.

Resources may include studies, reports, law review articles and other writings.
