Description

The Carrizo Comecrudo seeks to obtain federal recognition from the Office of Indian Affairs. The Tribe would like to obtain tribal access that would allow them to walk both sides of the Rio Grande River as their ancestors did. The Tribe has extensive genealogical research on the Mancias and Reyes families to aid in this process.

The federal recognition procedure is set forth in CFR 83 Part 25, Procedures for Federal Acknowledgement of Indian Tribes.
