### Description

BAJI, in collaboration with the American Immigration Council (AIC), is in ongoing litigation against ICE in response to FOIA requests related to detention centers in the U.S. South. The FOIA requests outline the extensive mistreatment of Black immigrants in eight immigration detention facilities in Texas, Louisiana, and Mississippi. The complaint describes disturbing instances of abuse in the context of systemic anti-Black racism in the detention system. Black immigrants report that they are subject to overtly racist statements and attacks by guards in facilities and are explicitly targeted because of their race. The complaint also cites reports of Black immigrants being threatened with pepper spray, beaten, and forced into restraint devices and confinement.
