### Description


The matter was referred by the Appleseed Foundation.

Black citizens are significantly less likely to be registered to vote than White citizens of the same age. This disparity is largest among young citizens: While 65% of White citizens aged 18 to 24 are registered to vote, only 55% of Black citizens in that age range are registered to vote.

The final deliverable for this research project will be a white paper that describes the systemic causes of the racial disparity in voter registration among young citizens, as well as promising policies and practices to increase the number of young Black citizens who are registered to vote.
