### Description

The matter was referred by the Transgender Gender Variant Justice Project (TGIJP).


The purpose of this project is to develop jurisdiction-specific legal resources for transgender gender variant and intersex (TGI) people in US custody. Black TGI individuals are overrepresented in prisons across the United States and are exposed to torture at the hands of the state on a regular basis. There are not enough attorneys working in this field to address the need so the Transgender Gender Variant and Intersex Justice

Project (TGIJP) is working with law firms and law students to create jurisdiction-specific resources to increase access to the legal research necessary to file a successful claim.

We currently have the support of Fried Frank and hope to get additional support to finalize our research through the LFAA. We have an in-depth concept note with additional details.
