Description

The Equal Justice Society seeks assistance with the following research question to advance its reparations work.

1. What are the main legal arguments being leveraged to attack government funded, race based policies or programs, including reparations polices and programs?

The final work product should include the following:


- Identify active litigation and key cases that involve a plaintiff suing a government entity attacking a race conscious policy or program.

- Identify the most commonly used claims and attendant legal theories/arguments in the identified cases, including 42 USC 1981 & 1983, and Title VI.
- Identify potential counterarguments and assess the viability of identified counter arguments, including, but not limited to, counter arguments to Article III standing, 12(b)(6) motions to dismiss, Rule 11(b) violation, and Rule 5.1 Constitutional Challenge to a Statute.
