### Description

The African American Redress Network (AARN) is conducting research and legal analysis related to reparations policy and relevant legislative frameworks across five research sites. Each Summer Associate will develop a detailed

chronology tracing governmental reparations initiatives at their assigned site, from initial proposal through implementation. The research will examine legislative design and legal form, governance and administrative structures, community engagement processes, funding mechanisms, and implementation outcomes.
